ICD-10 now codes based on loss of consciousness (LOC) time after the injury In order to ensure the most accurate and appropriate level of coding, documentation must clearly state if there was an LOC due to the injury and the duration of the LOC If documentation does not clearly define the LOC then unspecified state of consciousness must be coded
