About Middle English Grammar

English as a guide to the Middle English pronunciation (eg pig, edge); however, the j sound sometimes appears in Modern English as y (eg Middle English seggen 'to say') ʒ is the Middle English letter 'yogh' Between vowels such as a, o, and u it was pronounced like the ch in Scottish loch, but with more vibration of the vocal cords
